4th quarter tariffs

A few days ago you have received our tariff sheet for the 4th quarter (October 1st - December 31st 2006). Please make sure that you and your colleagues make use of this new tariff sheet as from October 1st, 2006.

A few small adjustments have been made to the rates in this tariff sheet. Although it is expected that most carriers will increase their boxrates for the Far East and India Sub continent, we have decided to not make any alterations to these areas.

HS Codes

We would like to remind you that HS codes are required for shipments to, or served via one of the following countries: South Africa, USA, Mexico, Indonesia, Pakistan. Please make sure to provide the correct HS codes upon booking.

IMO classified cargoes to Jakarta

New rules and regulations are forcing us to check with resp. authorities first before we can accept IMO classified cargoes to Jakarta or other destinations, which are being served via Jakarta. Therefore we request you to submit all relevant details and provide our booking desk with DGD's and MSDS's enabling us to make the proper application.

Due to the same rules and regulations, shippers are requested to act as follows:

- The name and telephone number of the 24 hours contact person or Safety Officer must be declared and mentioned on the bill of lading.
- The MSDS (Material Safety Data Sheet) must be attached to the packing of your shipment.

Non compliance may result in a penalty from the Jakarta port authorities. This penalty will be charged to either the shipper or consignee.

U.S. port security update: 100% scan

The U.S. Senate unanimously passed the Port Security Improvement Act, which requires to scan 100% of all containers entering any U.S. port. It is expected that this new law will be sent to the White House for the president's signature soon.

The new bill has been introduced to strengthen existing port security programs, as well as to introduce new legislations. The most important legislation would be the set up of a new pilot program that would screen 100 percent of cargo being sent to the United States, although there is no deadline for such action yet.

We will keep you informed about further updates or any possible adjustments to these new legislations.

"Update Fumigation WPM"

Based on the information available at time of publication, we have drawn up a listing of all countries, that have enforced the legislation on wood packing material (WPM), according to International Standard of Phytosanitary Measures (ISPM) No. 15 method.

We draw your attention to the fact that it is the responsibility of the shipper to make sure that the used WPM is in accordance with the laws and legislation of the country of destination.

All costs and consequences as a result of non compliance, will be brought for the account of the shipper. We must advise you that our CFS has no specific instructions, nor any liability to check on fumigation marks in general or on the validity or authenticity of the fumigation markings.
