Personal effects to Chennai

Please note that for every shipment of personal effects to Chennai, the Chennai Customs requires us to mention the following details on our Bill of Lading:

- Passport number
- Place of issue
- Country name

In order to meet these requirements, we ask you to provide us with the above mentioned details upon sending your B/L instructions. We cannot ship your cargoes without it,

Electronic filing procedure for Mexico

The Mexican Customs Authority had advised about new criteria for transmission to the Automatic Information Customs System. The most important change is that it will be mandatory for all Bill of Ladings and manifests to include a consignee Tax ID Number.

We kindly ask you to supply us with the following informations:

- Consignee Tax ID Number
- Telephone number
- Address details

Any shipments that do not meet this new requirement will be subject to fines.

Country of origin stamps for Saudi Arabia

The article hereunder was published in a previous bulletin, but we would like to remind you again about the regulations in Saudi Arabia.

Please be informed that with immediate effect it is required to mention "country of origin / made in" on each item and should also be shown on each box/carton (removable stickers not allowed).

Also the same must be mentioned on the Certificate of Origin as well. Please be informed that the exact country must be mentioned instead of "European Union". Any shipments that arrive without these marks or with unreadable marks, will be returned to the port of loading (re-export). Any additional costs will be for the account of the shipper.

The latest Dutch forwarding conditions filed with the Registry of the District Court of Rotterdam shall apply to all our forwarding business, which will be mailed upon request.

Risk Phrases to be required on MSDS

Please be informed that the European Union requires that Risk Phrases appear on each label and material safety data sheet for hazardous chemicals. Risk Phrases consist of the letter R followed by a number.

The Risk Phrase (or R Phrase in short) specifies the particular danger. For example, sodium metal must be denoted by R14/15 and R34 which correspond to "Reacts violently with water liberating highly flammable gasses" and "causes burns".

Safety phrases (S Phrases) for handling precautions are also part of the same requirements.

Please make sure you are aware of the new European Union requirements for hazardous goods documentation, as warehouses are no longer allowed to accept DG cargoes with incorrect documentation
