### NEW DG REGULATION USA

We would like to inform you about some upcoming changes with regard to the declaration of Dangerous Goods shipments to and from the USA.

The United States Department of Transportation's Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) has created a new regulation, which will go into effect as per October 1st.

**A** shipper who is registered with an emergency response provider must be identified by name or contract number on the shipping documents immediately before, after, above or below the emergency response telephone number in a prominent, readily identifiable and clearly visible manner that allows the information to be easily and quickly found.

This information is intended to enable the emergency response information provider to identify the offerer on whose behalf it is accepting responsibility for providing emergency response information in the event of a hazardous materials incident and to obtain additional information about the hazardous material as needed.

### ACI / AMS FILING REGULATIONS

Lately we have been noticing that exporters are not (completely) aware of regulations in regards to ACI and AMS filing.

We would like to remind you that Cleve has to submit their B/L instructions to the carriers at least 72 hours before departure of the ocean vessel. In order to comply with this rule, we urgently request you to provide us with your instructions in due time.

The actual filings with the Canadian and US Customs need to be done at least 24 hours before departure of the vessel.

In order to do the filing, we need the following info:

- Details of the actual shipper, consignee and notify (preferably including a valid e-mail address)
- The correct gross weight
- The number of the smallest unit of packaging
- A clear description of the cargo
- The HS code of the cargo

In case of Personal Effects, we also need a copy of the passport as well as a packing list.

### NEW REGULATIONS COLOMBIA

Our Colombian agent has informed us about a new custom rule, which needs to be followed in order to avoid delays and penalties.

For cargoes classified under chapters 50 to 64 of the Harmonized System (clothing and shoes), consignees have to do an anticipated customs clearance within 15 to 4 calendar days before the arrival of the cargo.

For this special requirement, the following sentence "DESCARGUE DIRECTO" has to be added to the consignee box on all transport documents. Descargue Directo means that custom clearance has to be done right after devanning.

### GENERAL RATE INCREASE EX USA

Steamship lines continue to restore their ocean rates from USA to Europe. We are forced to increase our LCL rates ex USA with **USD 6.00 w/m**, as per sailing date October 1st.



### CHANGE IN SERVICE TO EL PASO

We have decided to change our service to El Paso, TX. With immediate effect, we will send LCL shipments for El Paso via Los Angeles in stead of via Houston. This change enables us to maintain the rate we offer you.
