CLEVE GOES TO BALTIC / CIS COUNTRIES

Cleve recently entered into a cooperation with Trans-tira in Lithuania for import and export of LCL cargoes via the port of Rotterdam.

A weekly service is offered from Cleve's Rotterdam CFS to CFS Vilnius (with only 2 days transit) from which cargo is distributed throughout Lithuania, Latvia, Estonia, Russia, Kazakhstan, Belarus, Ukraine and Kyrgyzistan.

While services were offered since a number of years, this was mostly with transshipment via Gothenburg. It was time consuming and less cost effective.

The new set-up allows us to offer guaranteed weekly departures with an extra transit of only few day(s) extra for e.g. Riga (+1), Tallin (+2), Moscow (+4) St Petersburg (+4), Minsk (+4), Kiev (+8), Odessa (+8) and Almaty (+8). This makes Rotterdam the fastest N-European gateway into this region.

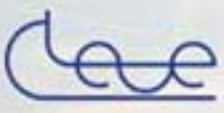


CERTIFICATION FOR EXPORTS IRAQ

Please note that the Iraq Central Organization for Standards and Control announced that with immediate effect, certain commodities require certification from SGS or Bureau Veritas before they will be allowed to enter Iraq.

The conformity certificate has to be obtained from the country of origin. For cargo that has already been shipped, inspection can be done at Umm Qasr or other ports of entry.

However, it is highly recommended that the cargo gets inspected and certified at country of origin to avoid potential delays.

It is one of many milestones in the 77 years of history of Cleve & Zonen.

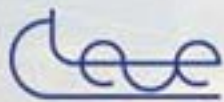
